



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE WESTERLY SIDE OF NORFOLK STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the year Two Thousand and Nine*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>

<u>Norfolk Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>35 feet in a southerly direction from its intersection with Amherst Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).
