



ORDINANCE

CREATING A BUS PARKING ONLY ZONE ON A PORTION OF THE NORTH SIDE OF CLEVELAND STREET NEAR FAIRGROUNDS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-61 “Parking in school zones”, subsection B of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-61. Parking in school zones.

There shall be no parking or stopping in a school zone during school hours:

...

- B. In school bus loops having posted signs at entrances or in pathways. Restricted parking includes but is not limited to:

<u>Cleveland Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Fairgrounds Elementary School: bus parking only along the north side of Cleveland Street from the eastern most entrance of Fairgrounds Elementary School easterly for a distance of 125 feet”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the appropriate sign(s).
