



ORDINANCE

CREATING A FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF LEWIS STREET AND MONROE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-4 “Stop intersections”, subsection D of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-4. Stop intersections.

...

- D. The following intersections are hereby designated as stop or through streets, and authority is hereby granted for the erection of a stop sign at the corner so designated in accordance with the tenor of this chapter:

<u>Lewis Street</u>	<u>North corner</u>	<u>Monroe Street</u>
<u>Lewis Street</u>	<u>South corner</u>	<u>Monroe Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the appropriate sign(s).

ANALYSIS

This legislation creates a four-way stop at the intersection of Lewis Street and Monroe Street by adding stop signs at the north and south corners of Lewis Street at its intersection with Monroe Street.

The erection, removal and maintenance of all traffic control devices must conform to applicable state statutes and the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. RSA 47:17 VIII (a). The Board should consult with the City Traffic Engineer to determine if this ordinance is in compliance.

ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING LEWIS STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET SOUTHWESTERLY FROM MONROE STREET TO LAKE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article VII “One-Way Streets”, Section 320-27 “One-way streets at all times”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-27. **One-way streets at all times.**

The following streets are hereby designated as one-way streets:

<u>Lewis Street</u>	<u>Southwesterly</u>	<u>From Monroe Street to Lake Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
