



ORDINANCE

RELATIVE TO THE USE OF THE GREELEY PARK BANDSHELL

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II "General Legislation", Chapter 215 "Parks and Recreation Areas", Article I "Park and Playground Rules" of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new section:

"§ 215-2.1. Greeley Park Bandshell.

Except for Summer Fun events and programs, use of the Greeley Park Bandshell shall be limited to non-amplified use until the noise mitigation recommendations in the April 30, 2003 technical memorandum entitled "Results of Noise Measurements and Recommendations Greeley Park Bandshell, Nashua, NH" prepared by Harris, Miller, Miller & Hanson, Inc. are completed."

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

ANALYSIS

Except for Summer Fun events and programs, the use of the Greeley Park Bandshell would be limited to non-amplified use until and unless the noise mitigation recommendations found in the April 30, 2003 technical memorandum entitled "Results of Noise Measurements and Recommendations Greeley Park Bandshell, Nashua, NH" prepared by Harris, Miller, Miller & Hanson, Inc. are completed.

These recommendations include the construction of an outer wall to block the direct sound path between the speaker cluster (and stage area) and the residences along Swart Terrace; an upper limit on concert sound levels; relocation and/or reorientation of the speaker cluster to take advantage of the shielding provided by the outer wall; and construction of an earth berm of sufficient height and length to break the line of sight between the band shell and homes along Berkeley Street.
