## RESCINDING THE NO-PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST HOLLIS STREET BETWEEN PALM STREET AND EATON STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Ten*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by deleting the struck-through language as follows:

“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

## ORDINANCE

### CHANGING THE NO-PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF WEST HOLLIS STREET BETWEEN PALM STREET AND PINE STREET TO A TWO-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONE

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Ten*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended as follows:

1. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets”, delete the struck-through language and add the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

West Hollis Street	South	From <del>Palm Street</del> <u>Pine Street</u> westerly to the westerly curbline of Eaton Street extended”

2. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas”, Section 320-38 “Two-hour parking”, subsection A, add the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.**

A. Parking shall be limited to two hours at all times on the following streets:
