**RELATIVE TO RESUMES OF DIVISION DIRECTORS AND DEPARTMENT HEADS

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Part 3 “Administrative Code”, Article IV “Generally”, Section 5-33 “Administrative divisions; officers and employees” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 5-33. Administrative divisions; officers and employees.

...

C. Posted on the City of Nashua’s website shall be either the current resumes of division directors and department heads or an indication that resumes are available for review in the Human Resources Department.”

This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
