AMENDING THE SOLID WASTE ORDINANCES TO REQUIRE COLLECTION ITEMS TO BE PLACED WITHIN A PROPERTY OWNERS' LOT LINE FRONTAGE AND REMOVING THE PROVISION REGARDING LANDFILL SECURITY

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Ten

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 270 “Solid Waste”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Article III “Sanitary Landfill”, delete Section 270-17 “Security” in its entirety:

~~“§ 270-17. Security.~~

~~Adequate security shall be provided at the Four Hills Landfill.”~~

2. In Article VI “Residential Collection”, Section 270-31 “Placement”, add the following new subsection C, and reletter existing sections C and D as D and E:

“§ 270-31. Placement.

No person shall put or place, or cause, suffer or permit to be put or placed, any residential waste, refuse, rubbish or garbage upon or near any sidewalk or public way for the purpose of public or private collection thereof except in accordance with the following standards:

...

- C. All trash carts, recycle bins, soft yard waste containers, as well as any bulky items requested to be removed by the City of Nashua Solid Waste Department, must be placed within the confines of the lot line frontage of the property address of all properties in residential zones.”

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

C. All trash carts, recycling carts, recycle bins, soft yard waste containers, as well as any bulky items requested to be removed by the City of Nashua Solid Waste Department, must be placed within the confines of the lot line frontage of the property address of all properties in residential zones, unless otherwise specified by the Solid Waste Department.

D. Penalty. Warning or suspension of service until such time as compliance is achieved as determined by the Department of Solid Waste.”

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

1. In Section 270-31 “Placement”, add the following new subsection C, and reletter existing sections C and D as D and E:

“§ 270-31. Placement.

No person shall put or place, or cause, suffer or permit to be put or placed, any residential waste, refuse, rubbish or garbage upon or near any sidewalk or public way for the purpose of public or private collection thereof except in accordance with the following standards:

...

C. All trash carts, recycling carts, recycle bins, soft yard waste containers, as well as any bulky items requested to be removed by the City of Nashua Solid Waste Department, must be placed within the confines of the lot line frontage of the property address of all properties in residential zones, unless otherwise specified by the Solid Waste Department.”

2. In Section 270-33 “Violations and penalties”, add the following new underlined language:

“§ 270-33. Violations and penalties.

Any person who violates any provisions of this article may receive a warning or have their service suspended until such time as compliance is achieved as

determined by the Solid Waste Department. In addition, any person who violates any provisions of this article may be fined and/or issued a citation pursuant to § 1-12 of the City Code. For purposes of this section, person includes the owner of the property or any other person or persons with authority to effect compliance with this chapter.”

This ordinance shall become effective upon date of passage.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
