



## ORDINANCE

### ADOPTING CERTAIN TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES ON A PORTION OF LEDGE STREET

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Ten*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-11 “Streets with traffic-calming measures”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new paragraph in the appropriate alphabetical order:

**“320-11. Streets with traffic-calming measures.**

Pursuant to § 320-10, the following described traffic-calming measures shall be installed and maintained:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Location</b>

Ledge Street	Raised crosswalks and curbed bumpouts on the portion of Ledge Street located between its intersection with Twelfth Street and its intersection with Eleventh Street.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

**FISCAL NOTE:** The cost of this project will be funded through grant funds. (R-08-90 authorized the acceptance and appropriation of \$44,500 from the New Hampshire Department of Transportation into Special Revenue Account #353-9123 "Safe Routes to School – Ledge Street" for the purpose of making intersection improvements near the Ledge Street School.)

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**ANALYSIS**

This ordinance will allow a raised crosswalk with curbed bumpouts on the portion of Ledge Street located between Eleventh and Twelfth Streets for the purpose of reducing excessive travel speeds.

Pursuant to NRO Sec. 320-10, C, this ordinance shall be referred to the Board of Public Works for its advice, and the Board of Public Works shall issue a recommendation to the Board of Aldermen within 30 days of receipt of such referral.
