



ORDINANCE

AMENDING A NO PARKING ZONE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF A PORTION OF LOCK STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding new underlined language as follows:

“§ 320-69. **No parking on certain streets.**

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location

Lock Street	South	From the east line of <u>Between</u> Tolles Street for 35 feet east and <u>Lucier Street</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
