



ORDINANCE

RELATIVE TO PUBLIC PARTICIPATION DURING COMMITTEE MEETINGS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I "Administrative Legislation", Chapter 5 "Administration of Government", Article II "General Provisions", Section 5-9 "Standing committees" of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new subsection:

"§ 5-9. Standing committees.

...

E. Committee meetings may include informational discussions that involve members of the public, but members of the public shall not participate in debate on a motion, and members of the public shall be in the gallery area of the aldermanic chamber whenever a vote is taken.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
