

ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING A NO PARKING ZONE ON A PORTION OF ABBOTT STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, hereby be further amended by adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order as follows:

“§ 320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Abbott Street</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From Amherst Street to a point 220 feet to the north.”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
