



ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE COMPENSATION OF POLLING ELECTION OFFICIALS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve

The City of Nashua ordains that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 23 “Elections and Campaigns”, Article I “General Voting Procedures”, Section 23-4 “Compensation of election officials” is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

“§ 23-4. Compensation of election officials.

- A. Election officials appointed or elected pursuant to state or local law shall be compensated as follows for all duties performed in connection with their respective offices, for each election held in the wards of the City:

(1) Moderators and Clerks, per election	\$165.00	<u>\$190.00</u>
(2) Selectmen, per election	\$140.00	<u>\$165.00</u>
(3) <u>Ballot inspectors, assistant election officials</u> and voter registrars, per election	\$120.00	<u>\$150.00</u>

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.



ASSIGNMENT:**

FISCAL NOTE: For any election other than a Presidential Primary or the State General Election at which votes will be cast for President of the United States: an additional \$2,745 per election. For a Presidential Primary or the State General Election at which votes are being cast for President, the city's polls would be staffed with an additional 73 ballot inspectors and voter registrars, and the total fiscal impact would be an additional \$2,190 per election.

ANALYSIS

This ordinance increases the compensation of polling election officials.
