



ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE PARKING ZONES ON PORTIONS OF LOWELL STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas” delete the struck-through language and add the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§320-35. Fifteen-minute parking.

...

C. No motor vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 15 minutes from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on any day, except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Lowell Street	South	From a point 25 <u>27</u> feet west of the westerly curbline of Orange Street extended to a point 75 <u>70</u> feet west of the westerly curbline of Orange Street”

“§320-36. Thirty-minute parking.

No vehicle shall be stationed or remain for a period exceeding 30 minutes on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Hours	Location
...			

<u>Lowell Street</u>	<u>South</u> <u>All</u>	<u>From a point 70 feet west of Orange Street to a point 185 feet west of Orange Street”</u>
----------------------	-------------------------	--

“§ 320-38. Two-hour parking.

A. Parking shall be limited to two hours at all times on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Lowell Street	North	From a point 150 feet west of the west line of Orange Street west for a distance of 100 feet
Lowell Street	South	Beginning 75 feet west of Orange Street for a distance of 109 feet”

2. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” add the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Lowell Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From Orange Street westerly a distance of 200 feet”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).

ORDINANCE

AMENDING THE PARKING ZONES ON PORTIONS OF LOWELL STREET

In the Year Two Thousand and Twelve

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended as follows:

1. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking-Lot Areas” delete the struck-through language and add the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-37. One-hour parking.

F. One-hour parking shall be in effect at all times on the following streets:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Lowell Street</u>	<u>South</u>	<u>First seven (7) parking spaces on the south side of Lowell Street from the corner of Orange Street west from a point 27 feet west to a point 185 feet west of Orange Street</u>

2. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” add the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Lowell Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From Orange Street westerly a distance of 200 feet”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
