



ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING IN THE MIDDLE OF CUL-DE-SACS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined section:

“§ 320-54. Parking on sidewalks.

- A. No person shall at any time park an automobile, van, motorcycle or other motor vehicle on any sidewalk in the City for any period of time or obstruct any sidewalk in any way.
- B. Anyone violating this provision shall be fined a minimum of \$50. If not paid within seven days, the fine shall increase to \$60.

§ 320-54.1. Parking in cul-de-sacs.

- A. No person shall at any time park, stop, or stand an automobile, van, motorcycle or other motor vehicle in the middle of any cul-de-sacs in the City for any period of time.
- B. Anyone violating this provision shall be fined a minimum of \$50. If not paid within seven days, the fine shall increase to \$60.”

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.

ORDINANCE

PROHIBITING PARKING IN THE MIDDLE OF THE WHIPPLE STREET CUL-DE-SAC

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Thirteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” Section 320-69 “No parking on certain streets” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“320-69. No parking on certain streets.

No parking whatsoever shall be permitted on the following streets, except as provided by law:

Name of Street	Side	Location
<u>Whipple Street</u>	==	<u>In the middle of the cul-de-sac at the north end of Whipple Street”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective upon passage.
