



ORDINANCE

REDUCING THE SIZE OF THE JOINT SPECIAL SCHOOL BUILDING COMMITTEE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen

The City of Nashua ordains that in Part I "Administrative Legislation" Chapter 5 "Administration of Government", Part 2 "Board of Aldermen", Article II "General Provisions", Section 5-9 "Standing committees", subsection B (5) of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

- "(5) ~~Nine member~~ Joint committees: Joint Special School Building Committee comprised of ~~nine (9)~~ four (4) members of the Board of Aldermen and ~~the entire~~ four (4) members of the Board of Education as provided by and for the purposes of New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated Chapter 199."

All legislation or parts of legislation inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This legislation shall take effect upon final passage by both the Board of Aldermen and the Board of Education.

ANALYSIS

This legislation reduces the size of the Joint Special School Building Committee from 18 members to 8 members. RSA Chapter 199 ("Schoolhouses") addresses joint school building committees. RSA 199:3, II, (a) requires that the joint building committee be comprised of equal numbers of the board of aldermen and board of education, but does not require any particular total number of members.

This legislation must also be approved by the Board of Education.

As the current JSSBC has 18 members, the "new" 8 members, four from each board, will have to be appointed by the Presidents of the Board of Aldermen and Board of Education, and approved by each respective board.

Note that the language being amended is slightly different from the language found in the Code of Ordinances. However, the language being amended was taken from the original legislation, O-85-156.
