



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING ANGLED PARKING ON A PORTION OF THE WEST SIDE OF MAIN STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIV “Manner of Parking”, Section 320-80 “Forty-five-degree angle” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-80. Forty-five-degree angle.

A. Head-in Parking

On the following streets, every vehicle remaining in any one place thereon shall be parked at an angle of 45 degrees, with the right front wheel to the curb:

B. Back-in Parking

On the following streets, every vehicle remaining in any one place thereon shall be parked at an angle of 45 degrees, with the right rear wheel to the curb:

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and installation of the appropriate sign(s).



This legislation defines back-in angled parking and authorizes 45° back-in angled parking on the west side of Main Street from 40 feet south of West Pearl Street to 455 feet south of West Pearl Street. This is roughly between Alec's Shoe Store and Persian Rug Gallery.
