



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE COMPOSITION OF THE CABLE TELEVISION ADVISORY BOARD

#### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 12 “Boards, Committees and Commissions”, Article VI “Cable Television Advisory Board”, Section 12-20 “Membership” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“§12-20. Membership.**

CTAB will consist of 15-10 members total. The ~~six~~ five members who are appointed by the Mayor shall serve for three-year terms. The members are as follows:

- A. One member representing the Board of Aldermen who will also serve as liaison between CTAB and Board of Aldermen, appointed by the president of the Board of Aldermen.
- ~~B. Corporation counsel or his or her designee.~~
- CB. The Director of the Nashua Public Library or his or her designee.
- ~~D. The Chief of the Fire Department or his or her designee.~~
- ~~E. The Chief of the Police Department or his or her designee.~~
- FC. The Superintendent of the School Department or his or her designee.
- GD. The Director of the Information Technology Division or his or her designee.
- HE. One member of the Nashua business community, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Aldermen.

~~F.~~ Four members who are Nashua residents, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Aldermen.

~~J.~~ ~~The Director of the Public Works Division or his or her designee.~~

~~K.~~ ~~The Mayor or his or her designee.~~

~~L.G.~~ ~~One member representing emergency management, appointed by the Mayor and approved by the Board of Aldermen.~~ The Emergency Management Director or his or her designee.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This legislation shall take effect following its passage.
