



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE PARKING TIME LIMIT ZONES ON A PORTION OF CANAL STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order as follows:

I. In Article X “Parking Time Limits in Non-Parking Lot Areas”, Section 320-37 “One-hour parking”:

**“§ 320-37. One-hour parking.**

...

F. One-hour parking shall be in effect at all times on the following streets:

| Name of Street      | Side         | Location   |
|---------------------|--------------|--|
| ...                 |              |  |
| <u>Canal Street</u> | <u>North</u> | <u>From a point 15 feet west of Cross Street to a point 60 feet west of Cross Street</u> |

G. One-hour parking, 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, shall be in effect on the following streets:

| Name of Street      | Side         | Location  |
|---------------------|--------------|---|
| Canal Street        | North        | From the west line of Salvail Court westerly to the east line of Grove Street <u>Cross Street</u> |
| <u>Canal Street</u> | <u>North</u> | <u>From a point 60 feet west of Cross Street to the east side of Grove Street”</u>                |

2. In Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-65 “Parking near street corners”:

**~§ 320-65. Parking near street corners.**

A. No person shall park or otherwise leave a vehicle unattended adjacent to the curb or the edge of the pavement within 25 feet of the intersection of any street, with the exception of the following specifically named streets:

...

(2) Parking shall be prohibited within 15 feet of the northeast corner of the intersection of Canal Street and Cross Street (along Canal Street).”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal and/or installation of the necessary sign(s).
