



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE LOCATION OF PARKING SPACES ON LOWELL STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language and in alphabetical order if appropriate as follows:

1. In Section 320-62 “No parking between signs where indicated”:

**“§ 320-62. No parking between signs where indicated.**

- A. There shall be no parking whatsoever between duly erected signs stating “No Parking Between Signs.”
- B. The following shall be “No Parking Between Signs” areas:

<b>Name of Street</b>	<b>Side</b>	<b>Location</b>
...		
<u>Lowell Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>Between 95 feet east of Lock Street and 115 feet east of Lock Street”</u>

2. In Section 320-65 “Parking near street corners”:

**“§ 320-65. Parking near street corners.**

- A. No person shall park or otherwise leave a vehicle unattended adjacent to the curb or the edge of the pavement within 25 feet of the intersection of any street, with the exception of the following specifically named streets:

...

- (3) Parking shall be prohibited within 10 feet of the northeast corner of the intersection of Lowell Street and Lock Street (along Lowell Street).”
