CALLING FOR THE PREPARATION OF A REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS TO
PURCHASE THE FORMER FIRE STATION LOCATED AT 38 ARLINGTON STREET

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Mayor and administration shall prepare and issue a request for proposals to purchase the former fire station located at 38 Arlington Street. Said proposals shall include a plan to subdivide the lot (Sheet 22, Lot 5) containing the former fire station, as the lot also includes the former civil defense building (36 Arlington Street) and the Dr. Crisp Elementary School (50 Arlington Street). The cost of surveying and subdividing the property shall be borne by the purchaser.

Complicating this situation is that the fire station is located on the same lot (Sheet 22, Lot 5) as the former civil defense building (36 Arlington Street), currently rented to the Granite State Ballet School, and the Dr. Crisp Elementary School (50 Arlington Street). The proposals must include a plan to subdivide the lot, and the purchaser must pay the cost of surveying and subdividing.






