WHEREAS the City and the Nashua Dog Owners Group have been unable to agree on the terms and conditions of a lease;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Resolution R-06-59, Approving the Dog Park Proposal from the Nashua Dog Owners Group and authorizing the lease of city land on Grand Avenue (Lot # 121-93), is hereby rescinded, and the authorization for entering into a lease of city land on Grand Avenue (Lot #121-93) with the Nashua Dog Owners Group is hereby withdrawn.
