RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that that the City of Nashua and the Nashua Police Department are authorized to accept and appropriate the sum of \$40,175 from the State of New Hampshire into Special Revenue Account #331-6278 "2011 NH Drug Task Force Grant" for the purpose of law enforcement for the period of 07/01/2010 through 06/30/2011. This resolution also authorizes the transfer of \$15,000 from Account #590-23591 "Prior Year Escrows, Contingency, Police Grants" budgeted for this purpose into Account #331-6278 and contingent upon approval of the FY2011 escrow request.

FISCAL NOTE: The fiscal impact is a \$40,175 grant to the City to be used for a specific purpose.

ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City of Nashua and the Nashua Police Department to accept and appropriate the sum of \$40,175 from the State of New Hampshire into Special Revenue Account #331-6278 "2011 NH Drug Task Force Grant" for the purpose of law enforcement for the period of 07/01/2010 through 06/30/2011. This resolution also authorizes the transfer of \$15,000 from Account #590-23591 "Prior Year Escrows, Contingency, Police Grants" into Special Revenue Account #331-6278 contingent upon approval of the FY2011 escrow request.

Charter Sec. 53 permits the Board of Aldermen to transfer any unencumbered appropriation balance or any portion thereof from one department, fund or agency to another.

NRO § 5-130, H provides that "when proposed legislation to transfer or reappropriate a particular appropriation or portion thereof has had its first reading, such funds shall not be expended or transferred while the legislation is pending".
