

ANALYSIS

This resolution establishes that the properties acquired by the City from members of the Terrell family will be known as "Terrell Homestead Conservation Area". The City acquired these properties, through the efforts of the Conservation Commission, for conservation purposes. The property purchased from Rita M. Terrell at 11-13 Groton Road consists of 40.34 acres plus a trail easement. The property purchased from Albert W. Terrell at 35 Groton Road consists of 46.52 acres plus a trail easement. Subsequently, a conservation easement over both properties was conveyed to the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests.

The Conservation Commission, at its meeting of May 17, 2011, made a motion to recommend that these properties be known as "Terrell Homestead Conservation Area".
