

RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO STUDY AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE CITY'S PARKING GARAGES

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eleven

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that,

WHEREAS, the two city-owned downtown parking garages on Elm Street and High Street are valuable underused city resources that have an impact on the downtown economy and vibrancy; and

WHEREAS, Nashua City Charter § 47-a provides that the board of aldermen may appoint "committees of its own members or of citizens to conduct investigations into... any matter relating to the welfare of the municipality" and delegate "to such committees such powers of inquiry as the board of aldermen may deem necessary";

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua, that the board of aldermen appoint an ad hoc committee to study and make recommendations on the city's parking garages.

The committee will review ways to improve, upgrade, and revitalize the garages, with respect to their appearance, safety, and appeal. This could include, but is not limited to, some of the following ideas:

- bright paint schemes, murals, or urban art
- having personnel on-site
- possible amenities such as a coffee stand
- utilizing outside contractors to manage the garages
- electronic payment options

The committee shall consist of five aldermen appointed by the President of the Board of Aldermen and confirmed by the Board of Aldermen.
