FISCAL NOTE: Estimated cost to conduct the September 11th state primary election is \$28,843. Estimated cost to conduct the November 6th state general election is \$43,155.

ANALYSIS

This resolution establishes the poll times for the September 11, 2012 and the November 6, 2012 state elections.

The City Clerk states that the higher costs associated with the general election are due to the increased number of voter registrars and election officials that will be required to staff the polls for the presidential election and for increased postage costs associated with the anticipated volume of absentee ballots that will be mailed.
