RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and the Division of Public Health and Community Services are authorized to accept and appropriate \$269,000 from the State of New Hampshire Health and Human Services Department into Public Health and Community Services Grant Activity - "FY 2013 Emergency Preparedness" for the purpose of continuing the implementation of regional public health emergency response activities. These activities include, but are not limited to, hazards emergency planning, managing and updating the City of Nashua's plans and annexes for an emergency response, disease surveillance, early event detection systems and maintaining relationships between first responder agencies, hospitals and health care providers. This funding shall be in effect from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.






