



## RESOLUTION

**RELATIVE TO THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT FUNDS FROM THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$280,104, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF MATCHING FUNDS, AND AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF PARCELS IDENTIFIED AS TAX LOTS 36-1 AND 36-70**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and the Division of Community Development are authorized to accept and appropriate transportation enhancements funds from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation in the amount of \$280,104 into Community Development Grant Activity "Rail Trail Parcel Acquisition" for the purpose of acquiring two parcels now or formerly belonging to the Boston & Maine Corporation located to the north of East Hollis Street between Mason Street and Commercial Street and identified as Tax Lots 36-1 and 36-70;

**FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED** to authorize the transfer of required matching funds in the amount of \$70,026 from Department #181 "Community Development Prior Year Escrows", Account #83900 "Grant Match" into Community Development Grant Activity "Rail Trail Parcel Acquisition"; and

**FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the city is authorized to acquire the two parcels now or formerly belonging to the Boston & Maine Corporation located to the north of East Hollis Street between Mason Street and Commercial Street and identified as Tax Lots 36-1 and 36-70.

**FISCAL NOTE:**

**\$280,104 grant to the city to be used for a particular purpose. There is \$70,026 required in matching funds, which is requested from Community Development Prior Year Escrows, escrowed for this purpose.**

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**ANALYSIS**

This legislation authorizes the City of Nashua and Division of Community Development to accept and appropriate transportation enhancement funds from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation in the amount of \$280,104 into Community Development Grant Activity "Rail Trail Parcel Acquisition", authorizes the transfer of required matching funds in the amount of \$70,026 from Department #181 "Community Development Prior Year Escrows", Account #83900 "Grant Match", and authorizes the acquisition of two parcels now or formerly belonging to the Boston & Maine Corporation located to the north of East Hollis Street between Mason Street and Commercial Street and identified as Tax Lots 36-1 and 36-70, which is the purpose of the grant.

Charter Sec. 53 permits the Board of Aldermen to transfer any unencumbered appropriation balance or any portion thereof from one department, fund or agency to another.



Charter §77 provides that the planning board shall review and make recommendations to the mayor and board of aldermen on the purchase and sale of any land by the city.

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


