**ESTABLISHING POLLING TIMES FOR THE SPECIAL STATE ELECTION ON  
FEBRUARY 19, 2013, BEING HELD FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILLING A VACANCY  
FOR STATE REPRESENTATIVE IN DISTRICT 31 (WARD 4) AND ISSUING  
PRECEPTS TO THE SELECTMEN OF WARD 4**

**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua shall hold the State of New Hampshire Special Election for the purpose of filling a vacancy for State Representative to the General Court in Hillsborough County District 31 (Nashua Ward 4) on Tuesday, February 19, 2013, between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., and furthermore, that precepts shall be issued to the Selectmen of Ward 4 directing them to issue their warrants calling a special meeting of the voters in their ward.

**ANALYSIS**

This resolution sets the polling hours for the February 19, 2013 special election as required under RSA 659:4 and issues precepts to the Selectmen of Ward 4 directing them to post their warrants as required under NRO 23-8.

According to the City Clerk, polling hours must be set “no later than 30 days prior to a state election” (RSA 659:4); therefore, rules will need to be suspended so that the resolution can have a second reading and final passage at the January 8, 2013 Board of Aldermen meeting. Since the charter requires that funding for the special election be appropriated at the time the Board issues orders to post the warrants, Resolution R-13-088, which funds the cost of this special election, will also require a second reading and final passage on January 8, 2013.
