RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the mayor and Board of Aldermen recognize and congratulate those future leaders in the Nashua community upon their completion of the Nashua Youth Ambassadors Program 2014-2015.

WHEREAS, The Ethnic Awareness Committee was established “to facilitate communication between the ethnic community and city government” and to encourage understanding and appreciation of ethnic diversity in our City.

WHEREAS, the Ethnic Awareness Committee recognized that the City, its ethnic communities and city government and organizations would benefit from a program designed to educate youth among the city’s many diverse populations regarding the roles of city government and community organizations and organize those youths so they can prepare to be future community leaders.

WHEREAS, the Ethnic Awareness Committee established the Nashua Youth Ambassador Program 2014-2015 to identify and engage diverse young leaders, to empower young members of the community to engage in community activities and feel that they can make a difference in building safe and stronger neighborhoods.
