



RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A VOTE REGARDING THE PRESERVATION OF THE NASHUA MILLYARD CHIMNEY

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen

WHEREAS, R-12-013, amended, passed on April 24, 2012, resolved that the Nashua Millyard chimney is an important historic structure and symbol for Nashua, that the Board of Aldermen has authority to determine how the Nashua Millyard chimney should be preserved (subject to review by the Federal Highway Administration), that the Board of Aldermen encourages the development of proposals to maintain the Nashua Millyard chimney at its current height, and in the alternative, to restore the section of the Nashua Millyard chimney that has been recently removed, and finally that the Board of Aldermen intends to make the final decision regarding the preservation of the Nashua Millyard Chimney;

WHEREAS, the City went out to bid and received proposals for preserving the Millyard Chimney at various heights;

WHEREAS, those heights and the costs associated with each of them are as follows:

<i>Alternative</i>	<i>Chimney Final Height:</i>	<i>Cost</i>
#1	180 feet	\$921,700
#2	165 feet (Current height)	\$762,300
#3	150 feet	\$736,073
#4	120 feet	\$677,800

WHEREAS, an additional option would be for the City to remove the Millyard chimney.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Board of Aldermen take a vote to select one of these alternatives.
