



## **RESOLUTION**

**APPROVING THE LOCATION OF A NEW BENCH IN GREELEY PARK NEAR  
MANCHESTER STREET**

### ***CITY OF NASHUA***

*In the Year Two Thousand and Fourteen*

**WHEREAS**, NRO Section 5-43, B, (5), (a) states that there shall be no construction at Greeley Park except for construction approved by a majority of the Board of Aldermen after a public hearing, and that “construction” is to be construed broadly and includes any new construction of any type of structure or monument; and

**WHEREAS**, installing a bench in a new location in Greeley Park requires pouring a new concrete pad for the bench.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Board approves locating a new bench in Greeley Park near Manchester Street.
