



RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING A WAIVER OF METER FEES FOR 30 TEMPLE STREET

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Fifteen

WHEREAS the property located at 30 Temple Street is going to be reconstructing their parking deck and garage, which is used by customers and employees of businesses located in the 30 Temple Street building;

WHEREAS the owners of the property, CREG-Temple Street, LLC, have asked the city to be able to have those customers and employees use the seven metered parking spaces on the north side of Temple Street between Spring Street and Cottage Street, the seven metered spaces on Church Street, and the twenty-two metered parking spaces in the Library Annex Parking Lot at no charge during the reconstruction period;

WHEREAS the parking fee for metered on-street and lot parking in Zone III is \$0.50 per hour, or a meter bag for the purpose of facilitating construction renovation is \$10.00 per day; and

WHEREAS the owners of 30 Temple Street have requested that the city waive those fees as they provide a benefit to the city by allowing public parking in their private parking lot after hours.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City will permit CREG-Temple Street, LLC, the owners of 30 Temple Street, to use meter bags at no charge for the seven metered parking spaces on the north side of Temple Street between Spring Street and Cottage Street, for the seven metered parking spaces on Church Street, and for the twenty-two metered parking spaces in the Library Annex Parking Lot during the time period of their parking deck and garage reconstruction, to end no later than December 31, 2015.
