



ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE INSTALLATION OF A YIELD SIGN ON HILLSIDE DRIVE AT
ITS INTERSECTION WITH HILLS FERRY ROAD

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article III “Stop and Yield Intersections”, Section 320-5 “Yield intersections”, subsection C of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language:

“§ 320-5. Yield intersections.

...

C. The following shall be yield intersections:

Yield Sign on	At Intersection With
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...

<u>Hillside Drive</u>	<u>Hills Ferry Road”</u>
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All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation of the appropriate sign(s).

This legislation authorizes the installation of a yield sign on the northeast corner of Hillside Drive at its intersection with Hills Ferry Road.

The erection, removal and maintenance of all traffic control devices must conform to applicable state statutes and the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices. RSA 47:17 VIII (a). The Board should consult with the City Traffic Engineer to determine if this ordinance is in compliance.
