



ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING TWO HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACES ON ELM STREET IN FRONT OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND COMMUNITY SERVICES BUILDING

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Eight

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XII “Parking, Stopping and Standing”, Section 320-72 “Handicapped parking” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the following new paragraph in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-72. Handicapped parking.

...

A. The following parking spaces are designated as spaces for the handicapped:

Name of Street	Number of Spaces/Type	Location
<u>Elm Street</u>	<u>2</u>	<u>West side, 25 feet south of Mulberry Street extending 50 feet to a point 75 feet south of Mulberry Street. Two spaces at 25 feet each.”</u>

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary signs.
