



# ORDINANCE

## ESTABLISHING NORFOLK STREET AS A ONE-WAY STREET

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Nine*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part II “General Legislation”, Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article VII “One-Way Streets”, Section 320-27 “One-way streets at all times”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by adding the following new underlined language in the appropriate alphabetical order:

“§ 320-27. **One-way streets at all times.**

The following streets are hereby designated as one-way streets:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel	Location

<u>Norfolk Street</u>	<u>Southwesterly</u>	<u>Entire Length</u> ”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of installation or removal of the appropriate sign(s).
