



ORDINANCE

UPDATING THE ABANDONED VEHICLES ORDINANCE

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article V “Parking and Stopping”, Div. 6.5 “Abandoned Vehicles”, Sec. 13-343 “Prohibited; definition; penalty; liability for costs”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the new underlined language and deleting the struckthrough language as shown:

“Sec. 13-343. Prohibited; definition; penalty; ~~liability for costs.~~

(a) It shall be a violation of this chapter to abandon any motor vehicle anywhere in the city.

(b) For the purpose of this division, an abandoned motor vehicle is any motor vehicle which remains standing in one (1) place for more than forty-eight (48) hours under circumstances which would lead a reasonable person to conclude that the vehicle has been abandoned.

(c) Any person violating this section shall be subject to a fine of at least two hundred and seventy-five dollars (\$20075.00), and this fine shall be inclusive of the cost of towing.

~~(d) Any person who abandons a motor vehicle on private property shall be liable to the owner of the property for the cost of removal, storage and disposal of said vehicle.”~~
