



ORDINANCE

INCREASING THE MINIMUM FINE FOR VIOLATIONS RELATING TO PARKING METER VIOLATIONS

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 13 “Motor Vehicles and Traffic”, Article V “Parking and Stopping”, Division 7 “Violations and Penalties”, subsection (b) be and is hereby amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding new language in underline as follows:

“Sec. 13-351. Stopping, standing or parking violations.

(b) Any person violating subsection (a) shall be fined ~~five~~ten dollars (\$~~5~~10.00) and if such fine is not paid within seven (7) days that fine shall be increased by ~~five~~ten dollars (\$~~5~~10.00) to a total of ~~ten~~twenty dollars (\$~~1~~20.00). Fines shall be paid to the city traffic violation bureau. Any person desiring a hearing shall within seven (7) days make request therefor, whereupon complaint shall be entered in city district court. . . .”

This ordinance shall be effective August 1, 2005.
