



## ORDINANCE

### PROHIBITION AGAINST DISCHARGE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF FIREWORKS BETWEEN 10:00 P.M. AND 8:00 A.M.

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Five*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Chapter 8 “Fire Prevention and Protection”, Article V “Fireworks”, Section 8-87 “Prohibition of Class C fireworks” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by adding the following new subsection:

“(d) It shall be unlawful to use, discharge or display salute, reports, or thunder shell fireworks between 10:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. There shall be only color shells, cakes, and whistlers used, discharged or displayed after 10:00 p.m. All permits issued shall specify the time period during which the fireworks display shall be conducted. The only exceptions would be Independence Day, New Year’s Eve, the Holiday Stroll, and City sponsored events with a minimum of a 24-hour notice.”
