



ORDINANCE

FREEZING THE MAYORAL SALARY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Five

The City of Nashua ordains that Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Officers and Employees”, Division 2 “Mayor”, Section 2-197 “Mayoral salary”, of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by the addition of the following underlined language at the end of the existing section:

“**Sec. 2-197. Mayoral salary.**

....

From January 1, 2004 through June 30, 2004, the mayor’s salary shall be based on an annual salary of \$89,500. On July 1 of 2004 and on July 1 of each following year, the mayor’s salary shall change by a factor equal to the average of the changes in the Consumer Price Index – Urban (CPI-U) of the preceding three (3) calendar years as published by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Notwithstanding the above language regarding a change in the mayor’s salary, for fiscal year 2006 only, the mayor’s salary shall not change and shall remain at the mayor’s fiscal year 2005 salary.”
