



## ORDINANCE

### ESTABLISHING MAYORAL AUTHORITY FOR APPOINTMENTS TO THE ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eight*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Chapter 190, entitled “Land Use,” Article XXXIX “Zoning Board of Adjustment” Section 190-255 “Zoning Board of Adjustment; membership” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be hereby further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 190-255. Zoning Board of Adjustment; membership.**

...

B. The Zoning Board of Adjustment shall consist of five members who are residents of the City appointed by the ~~President of the Board of Aldermen~~ Mayor and confirmed by the Board of Aldermen. Five alternates shall be chosen in a like manner. An alternate shall vote in the absence of a member.

...

D. As terms expire or vacancies occur the ~~President of the Board of Aldermen~~ Mayor, subject to the confirmation of the Board of Aldermen, shall make such appointments as necessary to comply with this section and RSA Chapter 673:3. Vacancies shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term.

...

F. The ~~President of the Board of Aldermen~~ Mayor shall submit a new appointment or a reappointment of a member or alternate to the Board of Aldermen not later than three months prior to expiration of the current term of office. If confirmation is denied or the appointment is withdrawn, the ~~President of the Board of Aldermen~~ Mayor shall submit a different appointment to the Board of Aldermen not later than on the last day of expiration of the member or alternate current term of office.”

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect following its passage.
