



## ORDINANCE

### AMENDING THE OVERNIGHT PARKING TIME LIMITS

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eight*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Chapter 320 “Vehicles and Traffic”, Article XIII “Night Parking”, § 320-78 “Parking time limits” of the Nashua Revised Ordinances, as amended, be and hereby is further amended by deleting the struck-through language and adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 320-78. Parking time limits.**

- A. Except as hereinafter provided, it shall be unlawful for an operator of any vehicle to park the vehicle for a period longer than two hours between 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m., Monday through Friday, except any City holiday and the day following a City holiday, on any public way in the City.
- B. Anyone violating this provision shall be fined a minimum of \$25. If such fine is not paid within seven days, the fine shall increase by \$10, to \$35.”

Deleted: daily

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective at the time of removal or installation of the necessary sign(s).
