



## ORDINANCE

### PERMITTING THE MAYOR TO CHANGE THE DATE OF A FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Eight*

*The City of Nashua ordains* that Part I “Administrative Legislation”, Chapter 5 “Administration of Government”, Article XXIV “Finance Committee”, Section 5-122 “Composition; duties” is hereby amended by adding the new underlined language as follows:

**“§ 5-122. Composition; duties.**

- B. The Finance Committee shall meet on the first and third Wednesday of every month, unless this date falls on a holiday, in which case the meeting shall be held on the first regular business day following the holiday. The Mayor may change the date of the Finance Committee meeting if the warrant is the only item on the agenda or call a special meeting of the Finance Committee, duly noticed. The Committee shall supervise the finances and accounts of the City. The Committee shall carefully examine and audit all accounts and demands properly laid before it and shall allow and approve such accounts and demands if they are found to be correct or due.”
