HONORING A DEVOTED AND OUTSTANDING NASHUA NATIVE,  
ADAM C. GURECKIS, SR.

### *CITY OF NASHUA*

*In the Year Two Thousand and Four*

**RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that

WHEREAS, Adam C. Gureckis, Sr. is a native of Nashua and Ward 7 for 80 years; he graduated from Nashua Senior High School in 1944 and attended the University of NH and Lowell University; he has been married to Evelyn M. Gureckis for 58 years and has 8 children, 15 grandchildren and 1 great grandchild; he retired in 1987 from Nashua Corporation after 40 years of service; he owned and operated WDER Radio in Derry, NH, a Christian formatted station, from 1983 until its sale in 2000; he is presently employed part-time as chief engineer of WDER Radio, Derry, NH, and Healthcare Review, a healthcare trade publication which is his daughter Connie's company; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gureckis was Ward 7 alderman from 1982 to 1994 and served on various committees – 10 years budget, 6 years planning and economic, 12 years traffic, 8 years rules and license, 6 years joint school committee, 4 years finance, 4 years personnel, 4 years land and buildings; trustee of the Board of Public Works Pension Fund; he oversaw the expansion and renovation of many Nashua school buildings; Mr. Gureckis was also recognized by the City of Nashua in 1993 by Mayors Rob Wagner, Maurice Arel, and James Donchess as an outstanding alderman and state representative, and for his many years of exemplary service to the Nashua community; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gureckis was a state representative for the NH General Court District #30 from 1988 to 1992; a member of the Ways and Means Committee from 1988 to 1992; served on numerous sub committees; was the executive member of the Hillsborough County Delegation (vice chairman) from 1990 to 1992; received the 1992 Outstanding State Legislator Award; received the 1987 NH Democratic Party Distinguished Service Award; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Gureckis received the Max Silber Community Service Award from the United Way of Greater Nashua in 2002; served as chairman of the Supervisory Committee on the Board of Directors of Triangle Credit Union for 27 years; vice president of the Board of Directors of Harbor Homes; chairman of the Management Committee; member of the Board for 17 years; supporter of the Plus Company Home on Harbor Avenue, Harbor Homes on Allds Street, and Nashua Children's Association home on Concord Street, due to his strong convictions that the placement of the less fortunate into the community must continue and that hope must exist for these people, as it does for every human being; Board of Directors for the first Bambino
