



RESOLUTION

SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS AT THE NEXT MUNICIPAL ELECTION THE QUESTION OF WHETHER TO CHANGE FROM A POLICE COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AND COUNCIL TO A POLICE COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua

WHEREAS, the appointment and removal of the Board of Police Commissioners and the Board's powers and duties are prescribed by Section A-101 through 107 of the Related Laws attached to the City Charter; and

WHEREUNDER, Section A-101 and 102 police commissioners are appointed and removed by the governor with the advice and approval of the council; and

WHEREAS, under Section A-141 through 146 the voters may elect to have the mayor and board of aldermen appoint the police commission with powers and duties prescribed in Section A-141 through 146; and

WHEREAS, the procedure for such a change requires majority vote of the board of aldermen to present a special question to the voters at a regular municipal election; and

WHEREAS, the board of aldermen finds that it is in the public interest to present the question to the voters.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT

The following special question shall be presented to the voters at the November 2005 municipal election:

“Shall the city of Nashua authorize the mayor and board of aldermen to appoint a police commission instead of having the governor and governor's council appoint the commission?”
