



RESOLUTION

RESCINDING AND REPLACING THE PARKING SPACE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE NASHUA ASSOCIATION FOR THE ELDERLY WITH REGARD TO PARKING IN THE CITY'S TEMPLE STREET PARKING LOT

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Four

WHEREAS, the City of Nashua entered into a Parking Space Agreement with the Nashua Association for the Elderly on December 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nashua passed Resolution R-94-34 on May 24, 1994 which amended the Parking Space Agreement of December 7, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the City of Nashua passed Resolution R-02-39 on May 14, 2002 which amended the December 7, 1987 Parking Space Agreement and Resolution R-94-34; it is now hereby

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua rescinds all prior agreements and resolutions with regard to parking by the Nashua Association for the Elderly in the City's Temple Street Parking Lot; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that all parking on the land surrounding the planned Senior Activity Center and Senior Housing, currently referred to as the City's Temple Street Parking Lot shall be provided free of charge to be used as parking for the planned Senior Activity Center and Senior Housing. This resolution shall take effect upon passage, and replace all other agreements and resolutions with regard to parking at this site.
