RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that pursuant to NH RSA 31:19-a, the City of Nashua hereby establishes an expendable trust fund for the purpose of accepting contributions from developers for transportation improvements to East Pearl Street and Temple Street and appoints the board of public works as the agent to expend under RSA 31:19-a. Any balance remaining in this expendable trust fund at each fiscal year end will not lapse or be closed out to the General Fund, but will remain in this expendable trust fund for future transportation improvements to East Pearl Street and Temple Street.
