



RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE DELEGATION FROM NASHUA TO REJECT HB1339 IN THE 2006 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Five

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that

WHEREAS legislation has been proposed in the form of HB1339 for the 2006 legislative session which would change the rules for voting on local land use boards; and

WHEREAS said legislation would cause any tie vote of a land use board to be considered a decision in favor of the applicant; and

WHEREAS the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua finds this change to be offensive to the very concept of decision making by the majority of a body; and

WHEREAS the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua finds that this change would undermine the ability of Nashua to protect the character of its neighborhoods and the value of its residents' properties.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Board of Aldermen respectfully requests that the state legislative delegation of Nashua reject HB1339.
