HONORING MOOREMART
CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Six

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen recognize MooreMart, this fall's chosen honoree of the Mayor's Volunteer Recognition Committee.

MooreMart volunteers have collected, packed, and shipped over 4,000 care packages for soldiers in Iraq, Afghanistan, and Kuwait. They also send packages of school supplies to children in newly built schools in Afghanistan. Founders Carole and Paul Moore devote 30 hours a week to the project, and, during busy periods, hundreds of volunteers spend entire weekends on the project.

In addition to providing American servicemen and women overseas with snacks, toiletries, and cards and letters from people at home, MooreMart lifts morale among the troops by providing concrete proof of the care, concern, and support of their community. Donations of school supplies contribute to the success of Afghan children, including some who never before had an opportunity to receive an education.
