RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky served on the Nashua City Planning Board from March 1, 1990 to January 2007 (nearly 17 years of continuous service) with exemplary attendance; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky served as Chair of the Nashua City Planning Board from February 1997 to January 2007; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky served as Chair of the Capital Improvements Committee, a charter subcommittee of the Nashua City Planning Board, from January 1992 to January 1999; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky also served as alternate member representing the Nashua City Planning Board on the Nashua Regional Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky was Chair of the City-wide Master Plan Committee formed by the Nashua City Planning Board to update the City's Master Plan, which was adopted in December 2001; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky also served on and participated in the updates to the City's Downtown Master Plan, East Hollis Street Master Plan, and other board planning initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky served on the Planning board during a time of redevelopment of the Daniel Webster Highway and Amherst Street, and during the revitalization of the Downtown; and

WHEREAS, Bette R. Lasky is recognized for bringing civility and fairness to the Planning Board and always gave applicants and abutters time to address the Planning Board, while maintaining orderly conduct of meetings, leading to sound decisions.
