



RESOLUTION
RECOGNIZING AARP TAX AIDE
CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen recognize AARP Tax Aide. This agency was this year's chosen honoree of the Mayor's Volunteer Recognition Committee.

The AARP Tax Aide volunteers perform an invaluable public service each year by helping seniors and low-income taxpayers file their income tax returns.

Sponsored by the AARP Foundation and the IRS, in 2006 the volunteers electronically filed 906 federal and 112 Massachusetts tax returns.

A total of twenty-seven volunteers are assisting taxpayers at the Nashua Public Library this year, and five more work at the Nashua Senior Center. After undergoing intensive training, including a test that takes 12 hours to complete, they donate 5 to 10 hours of their time per week during the 10-week tax season.

AARP Tax Aide helps seniors and low-income taxpayers maintain independence in their financial affairs. These volunteers give their time in the spirit of community and caring that the Mayor's Volunteer Recognition Committee seeks to foster.
